Admissions

Inquiries are welcome throughout the year, and application materials are available in the office for entry the following fall. Families are encouraged to visit Ho`ala School during class times before beginning the application process. Those seeking admission to Ho`ala High School must submit their completed applications and participate in testing and/or group activity sessions held on Ho`ala's campus. In addition, the admission's process may include conversations with parents, candidates and the Head of School to determine what is needed to have the student be successful at Ho`ala.

Graduation

A minimum of twenty-four credits is required for graduation from Ho`ala High School, with one credit awarded for 120 hours of study. Most courses require demonstrations of knowledge through portfolios or exhibitions. The twenty-four credits include the following:

Science	3 credits
Foreign Language	2 credits
Performing/Fine Arts	2 credits
Physical Ed	2 credits
Guidance/ Health	2 credits
Technology	1 credits
Elective Courses	2 credits
Technology	.5 credit
